The Red Cloud Community Schools Board of Education held their regular monthly board meeting on Monday, June 20, 2022 in the Library at Red Cloud Elementary School. President Armstrong called the meeting or order at 12:15 p.m. with members Armstrong, Hobbs, Horne, Mahin and VanWey answering roll. Peterson was absent.

Mahin moved to excuse Robin Peterson from the meeting. Horne seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Mr. Heldt, Secondary Principal, reported that Summer School has been completed at the high school, and the Summer Weights Program is underway with around 45 students participating. Junior High students have been doing some Agility training and the high school students are lifting. Red Cloud hosted the TVC All-Star Boys & Girls Basketball Games and the All-Star Volleyball Game. Participating from Red Cloud were Landon Mahon and Beau Lewis. FFA students recently completed PACE and a Leadership Officer Retreat. Brooks Armstrong attended Cornhusker Boys State being sponsored by the Cowles American Legion. Mr. Heldt also noted that Samantha McDole, Cindy Haskins and Ron Brumbaugh have been working on cleaning, painting, etc. at the high school. He noted that the old cement pad where the metal building set has been removed and that the new windows should be coming soon. Mr. Heldt also gave the Board a copy of the Extra-Curricular Assignments as they stand at this time for the 2022-2023 school year.

Mrs. Dallman, Elementary Principal, reported that the elementary staff have attended Kagan 2 Instructional Strategies, a Science Retreat, Reading course and Marzano updates. They also completed Big Ideas Math follow up training at the end of the school year. The new Science Curriculum has been received and there will be some training for this curriculum. She noted that she had attended the Rule 11 meeting and that there will be some Pre-School monitoring changes coming out. Interviewed for the SPED position last week. Summer School for the Life Skills students was completed during the weeks of June 6<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>. Also Pre-School held their first week of Summer School. Mrs. Dallman indicated that she would be attending the Instructional Leadership Principal Retreat this Friday and there will be a couple of staff attending the Google Summit in service in Lincoln. She also reported that Mercedes DeJonge from Franklin was interested in becoming a Local Substitute for Red Cloud.

Superintendent Hof talked about the Depreciation Fund and its uses. He reported that Mr. Brumbaugh is working on the drawings for the building at the high school and that the doors and windows for the elementary along with the Library should be installed soon. He noted that he may have someone that is interested in the School Nurse position. He also shared information on Professional Responsibility and "How not to get Fired". He noted that this information will be presented to all staff at the start of the new school year.

Mahin moved to approve the agenda. VanWey seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Colby Coash from the Nebraska Association of School Boards, was in attendance at the meeting and visited with the Board about NASB and his responsibilities with the Association.

Horne moved to approve the minutes from the May 16, 2022 board meeting as presented. Armstrong seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Hobbs moved to approve payment of the District 2 and Special Building Fund Claims. Horne seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to accept the financial reports as presented. Armstrong seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

The Negotiations Committee indicated that they needed to meet with the Principal's to set their wages for next year, the Policy Committee met prior to the regular meeting and noted that Mr. Hof was going to make some changes to board policy and the handbooks regarding the Bullying Policy and the Building Committee stated that there has been some discussion regarding Restrooms at the Football Field.

Board communications included thank-you notes from Marilyn Fritson and Don Beitler.

Horne moved to approve the proposal from Mesker Construction for the Asphalt Seal Coating and extension of the asphalt for the elementary parking lot. Armstrong seconded the motion. Mahin asked if a walking area could be marked off for the kids to walk to the Valley Child Development Center when the parking spaces are marked. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Armstrong moved to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of Board Policy, Sections 100, 200 & 300. Hobbs seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Mahin moved to approve a teaching contract with Amy Reed for k-6 Special Education. VanWey seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to approve classified wages as recommended with hourly receiving a 60 cent per hour raise and salaried comparable with teacher increases. Armstrong seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 5-0 by roll call vote.

The next regular board meeting has been scheduled for Monday, July 18, 2022 at 12:00 Noon in the library at Red Cloud Elementary School. There being no further business, Mr. Armstrong declared the meeting adjourned at 1:24 p.m.
