

Red Cloud Community Schools
Board Minutes

The Red Cloud Community Schools Board of Education held their regular monthly board meeting on Monday, October 17, 2022 in the Library at the Red Cloud Elementary School. President Armstrong called the meeting to order at 7:02 a.m. with members Armstrong, Hobbs, Horne, Mahin, Peterson and VanWey answering roll.

Mr. Heldt, Secondary Principal, reported that the Juniors took the ASVAB Test last month and the Interpretation of the scores was completed recently; the FFA students attended District Land Judging with Brooks Armstrong qualifying for State competition to be held this Wednesday at North Platte; Homecoming was held with a lot of student, staff and community participation in the activities; NHS induction was held with six new members (Phoenix Kincaide, Pattie Arroyo, Avery Fangmeyer, Maliki Horne, Addie Minnick, Brenna Stocker) being inducted; the One-Act Crew accompanied by Mrs. McDole attended a performance at UNK; and Mrs. Burgess took the Juniors & Seniors for a college visit to UNK. The fall Junior High sports seasons (football, volleyball & cross country) are now complete with the teams having successful seasons. TVC volleyball started on Saturday with the Red Cloud girls beating Harvard in the consolation game. District Volleyball will be held next week and a teacher in-service will be held on Monday, October 24th, at Adams Central.

Mrs. Dallman, Elementary Principal, reported that the Early Childhood Report has been completed, she attended the SPED Targeted Improvement Plan webinar, and the 5th & 6th grades attended Earth Jamboree at Liberty Cove near Lawrence. The parent meetings for Science Fair and State Night (4th, 5th & 6th grades) were held last week with 87.5 % of the parents in attendance and PreK had Dads and Donuts with 95% of the Dad's in attendance. Katie Davis attended the MTTTS (Multi-Tiered System of Support) Summit in person while Mrs. Dallman attended via webinar. Upcoming events will include a PreK visit to the Fire Hall and visits from the Firemen for grades K-6, Certificated Staff will be attending the TLC Conference held at Adams Central on October 24th and ESU #9 will do Marzano Training with the teaching staff on November 1st with a late start for students at 10:00 a.m. Red Ribbon Week is next week.

Mr. Hof, Superintendent, notified the board that our school attorney, Cindy Volkmer, has been appointed as District Judge and therefore, another partner in her law firm will be taking over for her. He also noted that we do have plans for the Athletic Building and he will check with Mr. Brumbaugh to see if he has received a copy of them.

Peterson moved to approve the agenda. Hobbs seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to approve the minutes from the September 19th regular meeting, the Budget Hearing, Tax Request Hearing and the Special Meeting to approve the 2022-23 Budget and set the Tax Request. Mahin seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to approve payment of the District 2 claims. Hobbs seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to accept the financial reports as presented. Armstrong seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Armstrong moved to approve the 2nd reading of Board Policy, Section 500--Students with the changes that Mr. Hof presented to the Board. VanWey seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Horne moved to approve the 1st Reading of Board Policy Section 600, Instruction and 700, Business Operations with updates as presented. VanWey seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

Kim Ely presented information to the Board regarding the upcoming Science Trip to the Everglades in Florida from June 27th – July 1st and a trip to Cloud County Community College in Concordia, KS to take the Cadaver Tour. Horne moved to approve both trips. Mahin seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 6-0 by roll call vote.

The next regular monthly board meeting will be held on Monday, November 21, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Library at Red Cloud Elementary. There being no further business, Mr. Armstrong declared the meeting adjourned at 7:34 a.m.
